

Seizure Smart Schools Training Programs

Managing Students with Seizures: A Training for School Nurses is a continuing education program designed to provide the school nurse with information, strategies, and resources that will enable him/her to better manage the student with seizures by supporting positive treatment outcomes, maximizing educational and developmental opportunities, and ensuring a safe and supportive environment. Nurses can earn 3.2 continuing education credits for free through the CDC for in-person and online programs. In-person programs must be scheduled 3 weeks in advance for CEUs. Seizure Training for School Personnel is a continuing education program that provides teachers and other school personnel with information needed to recognize seizures, respond with appropriate first aid, and understand the impact seizures have on students. It is for elementary, middle, and secondary school staff, including teachers, administrators, cafeteria workers, security guards, custodians, bus drivers, or anyone else that encounters students. School personnel can earn 0.1 ANSI/IACET continuing education units, or 0.1 Category I continuing education contact hours for certified health education specialists through the CDC for in-person and online programs. In-person programs must be scheduled 3 weeks in advance for CEUs. Length of program: 1 hour. For the online course, please click [HERE](#).

Take Charge of the Facts is a classroom program designed specifically for tweens/teens to provide students with a basic knowledge of the different seizure types, first aid response, and a discussion to help reduce stigma and misperceptions about seizures and epilepsy. Length of program: 1 hour.
